Farm Bill Section 12101 Animal Health Programs Total Spending FY 2019 – FY 2022

NAVVCB - \$58.6 million

FMD vaccine antigen concentrate and FAD diagnostic test kits

NADPRP - \$22.1 million

Projects that enhance prevention & preparedness for high consequence animal disease outbreaks; 121 projects funded to date

NAHLN - \$16.9 million

Projects to support laboratory diagnostic capabilities for emergency response; 96 projects funded to date

Joint NAHLN/NADPRP – \$4.3 million

7 projects to advance FAD point-of-care diagnostic tests



FY 2023 Plans

NAVVCB - \$15 million

- \$15M in NAVVCB acquisitions for FMD VAD and FAD diagnostic test kits FY 2022

NADPRP – \$18 million

- \$17 million to support new projects in the regular funding opportunity
- \$500,000 for projects in the Tribal funding opportunity
- \$500,000 for 2 nationally-coordinated, APHIS-led projects.

NAHLN - \$7.5 million

- \$7.5 million to support new projects, including \$5.25 in noncompetitive funding for operational support and \$2.24 in competitive funding.
