



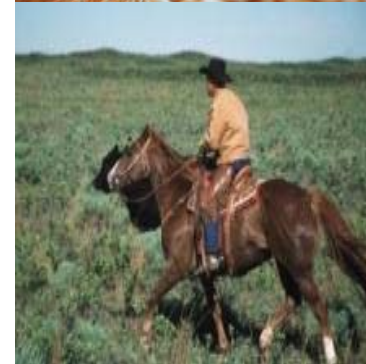

Current Status



- 232 premises: 211 commercial and 21 backyard
- Approximately 50 million birds killed
- Over half a billion dollars for response and indemnity
- Economy-wide impact of \$3.3 billion

Trade Impact

- 17 trading partners have suspended all U.S. poultry and poultry products:
 - China: \$391 million
 - Russia: \$153 million
 - South Korea: \$123 million



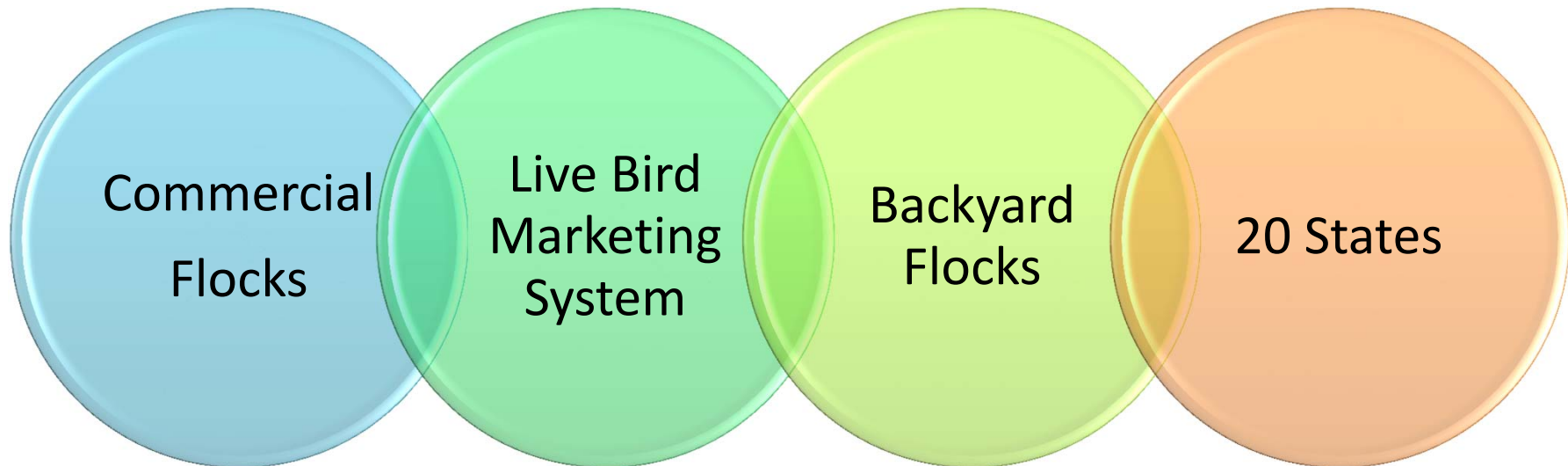
Travel Impact



- Asia, Africa, the Middle East, and Europe meetings to provide HPAI updates
- Most countries agreed to lift remaining bans, consider regionalization, and allow the use of vaccines
