**Parking:**

**Travel Planning:**

Please plan to arrive on Monday, June 12<sup>th</sup>, for a welcome reception with registration sponsored by Cambridge Technologies, from approximately 5-9pm. The Graduate Charlottesville is located just 8 miles from the [Charlottesville Albemarle Airport](#) and just 1 mile from the [Amtrak Train Station](#) and is easily accessible [by car](#) from Interstate 64.

**Tour Information:**

After lunch on Wednesday, June 14, we will be providing bus transportation to an agricultural-themed tour of Monticello, a visit to a local turkey farm, and a dinner at King Family Vineyards in Crozet. Dinner and drinks there will be sponsored by the Virginia Farm Bureau, the Virginia Agribusiness Council, Virginia Cattlemen's Association, Virginia State Dairymen's Association, and the Virginia Poultry Federation.

**Monticello Guidelines:**

- No bags or backpacks exceeding 12 x 6 x 12 inches are allowed beyond the Shuttle Station. New security bag check stations are a good reason to ensure all prohibited items are left at home or on the bus. View a full list of the [Do's and Don'ts](#) before your visit to avoid delays at bag check stations.
- While touring the House, eating, drinking, chewing gum and using tobacco products are prohibited.
- Guests are urged not to touch or lean on walls or furnishings.
- While on the grounds, the West Lawn is open to guests; otherwise, guests are asked to remain on designated paths and trails.
- Photography: Still photography, filming and video recording for personal use are permitted.
- Monticello is a tobacco-free and e-cigarette-free site. Smoking is not permitted near the house or its dependencies and terraces.
