- *A federal employee should be currently employed or recently retired (less than two years) to be eligible.
- Selection of the award will be made by the Executive Committee, with open nominations by USAHA members. The award will be presented annually during the President's Dinner at the Annual Meeting.
- **Deadline for Nominations is Wednesday, August 10, 2022**
