BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

A zero tolerance for salmonella in feed ingredients, and feed, is not practical, achievable or beneficial.

RESOLUTION:

The United States Animal Health Association (USAHA) urges the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) to change the regulation (21 CFR 500.35) that states all salmonella are adulterants.
